Doctor's appearance in court

- doctor as a witness x doctor as an expert witness
- in any kind of trial – disciplinary, criminal, civil ...
- legally different situations!

Doctor as a witness

- **witness** = any person who has been invited by the Police of the Czech republic to testify in court about the facts he/she perceived with his/her senses (what he/she saw, heard, did)
- irreplaceable
- testimony about a specific case (person) he was involved in (with)
- the duty to testify in court is universal (right to withhold denunciation)

Obligation to report a crime in doctor's practice

- in living individuals:
 - **abuse (any kind - CAN, sexual, physical ...)**
 - **murder**
 - **death**
- in the dead: **every crime**
 - not reporting a crime is a crime ...

Doctor – expert witness

- **the task of an expert witness:** using his/her expertise (knowledge, NOT experience!) to clarify facts and circumstances important for criminal proceedings (trial), if the fact needs such an expertise
- replaceable by another expert witness in a particular field
- appointed / revoked by: Ministry of Justice, regional courts (municipal court in Prague)
- conditions of appointment – professional and moral
- the oath of an expert, naming decree, expert card
- the List of experts
- the experts´ s seal and „signature“
- ad hoc expert

- mostly in criminal trials...
- asked to write an expert evidence by the Police, by court, by a lawyer, by a private person ...
- „examination and autopsy of a corpse“ – according to § 115 of the Criminal Code – always 2 experts in forensic pathology
- experts in health care sector:
 - different fields:
 - forensic pathology
 - psychiatry, sexuology
 - surgery
 - gynaecology/obstetrics

Expert evidence

- means of proof in court
- **ALWAYS** written
- expert's testimony in court – „oral confirmation“
- **finding, expertise, expert's clause + seal, signature**
- correct, clear and complete => professional, comprehensible, justified, objective, reviewable by logical procedure
- concise
- unbiased !
