Exhumation

- the retrieval of a previously buried body for postmortem examination
- Followed by a first autopsy or re-autopsy

- moving of graveyard
- suggestion that a death was due to criminal action
- ancient or historical circumstances

► a suspicion of poisoning → samples of earth from the surface of the grave, from other parts of cementery, soil above coffin

full photographic record

► bodies without identity → shalow grave in Ďáblice graveyard

Exhumation vs. retrieval of a clandestinely buried body:



- Exhumation must be differentiated clearly from the retrieval of a body clandenstinely buried body by the criminals. In the latter case, the body was never legally buried (or inhumed) in the first place.
- Retrieval of such a body is NOT exhumation
