Symbolic Employment of Women's Bodies

According to The Unified National Leadership of the Uprising, Intifada entails "the children and young men of the stones and Molotov cocktails; it is the thousands of women who miscarried as a result of poison gas and tear gas grenades" (quoted in Massad 1995, p. 475)

Israeli Women

"The index shows a startling rise in the frequency of cases of violence against single women (from 60 per 100,000 women in 2003 to 1000 per 100,000 in 2010) - a nearly twenty-fold increase. And according to the survey of 800 women from various sectors of the population, 76 percent of Jewish women and 79 percent of Arab women report living "in constant fear" of sexual assault. The survey found that one in every three women can expect to be sexually assaulted during the course of her life."
