

Chronological table

Ha C1 (800-675 BC) – hoards, Thraco-cimmerian bronze artefacts, collapse of Bronze Age centers, survival of **cremation rite both in HG and PG**

Ha C2-D1a (675-575 BC) – **elites in graves**, hoards in PG in Ha D, **inhumation rite in HG**

→ Ha C2 – **large burial mounds**, local chiefs, without significant centers

→ Ha D1a – end of local chiefs, Bratčice and compound belt ladies, beginning of institutionalization of the **Býčí skála Cave sanctuary**, hillfort

Ha D1b–LT A (575-370)

Ha D2 culminating centralization processes, elites disappearing from the landscape, moving to Býčí skála cave, hoards, duration of Hallstatt Period fortified hilltop settlements

in Ha D3 last elite in Býčí skála Cave, no other graves of elites; LT A new structure of hillforts, LT A hoards
