## *PT 233* (Mercer)

237a. To say: The serpent which came forth from the earth is fallen; the flame which came forth from Nun is fallen.

237b. Fall; glide away.

## PT 234 (Mercer)

238a. To say: A face is upon thee; thou who art on thy belly. Descend on thy backbone, thou who art in thy *n*<sub>3</sub>*w*.*t*-bush.

238b. Give away before the serpent who is provided with her two heads.

## CT 436 (Faulkner)

To drive off a snake and destroy his venom.

O you who cut off the necks and sever the heads of the foes of Osiris, O you HnbAA-snake which has neither arms nor legs, are you proud because of this which is on your mouth, which your mother has given to you? Your mother goes up to you, go off to her who regards you as weak.

## CT 1034 (Faulkner)

Down on your faces, you snakes of aftt, let me pass, for I am a mighty one, a Lord of might, I am a noble of Re, a lord of righteousness whom Edjo created, and my protection is the protection of Re. See, he has gone all over the Field of Offerings, which belongs to me, for I am Re, a greater god than you, he assesses his Enneads in giving offerings.
