- 1. Speaking; look at the statements in ex. 1, page 50; prepare your reactions.
- 2. Read the assignment for ex. 2, page 50, do the Reading task then. Prepare a summary of the text and your comments.
- 3. On page 51, first address the question in ex. 3, then go through the Phrase spot and complete the sentences below.
- 4. Grammar epistemic modality degrees of likelihood; revise the category from the point of morphology; then do exercises 1 and 2 on page 52.
- 5. On p. 53, look at the periphrastic ways of expressing modality (e.g. be bound to, be doubtful etc.) in exercise 4.
- 6. Complete the text Band Manufacture (ex. 5, p. 53) and provide answers to the questions below.
- 7. On page 54, do exercise 1 (if need be, check the pronunciation), then listen to exercise 2 and fill in the gaps.
 - (Check the script once you have done the exercise listen again, following the audio.) (Note: the text is grossly simplified and includes some false information e.g. pine mistaken for spruce (!), the varnish affecting the sound etc.)
- 8. Do the idiom spot and check your answers.

Optional task – do the second listening task and revise the syntactic/discourse functions of intonation.
