### Task description:

- 1) Please respond to the cfp.
- 2) Think of a topic that lies within the scope of your research interests.
- 3) Search for materials: remember to include some criticism of the approach you intend to present. Base at least on 5 sources: academic books (parts of passages), journal articles (of any length, parts or passages), handbooks from your area, Ted Talks, magazine articles etc.
- 4) Present the results of your research in a 15 min long presentation. **PLEASE DON'T READ OUT**, the goal is to practice speaking.
  - a. Structure the presentation into:
    - i. Intro: general information, the goal of the presentation, methodology
    - ii. Content –
      1. possibly visual materials (do not write a lot of text into your ppt, focus on the crucial information expressed in bullet points
      2. use at least a few full quotes (with reference – word has a tool for that – go to reference insert citation/vlozit citaci – then you choose a format e.g. APA, MLA, Chicago – I'd recommend any of these) and Word will do it for you plus it will create bibliography on its own.
    - iii. Conclusion
  - b. You could use powerpoint, but it's not necessary, the choice of the form is up to you, but an audio file is important (recorded and shared on youtube, just an audio file, ppt with sound etc.).
