Type I Vandalism

Incidents having both a high monetary cost as well as a high social cost.

Examples

- Destruction of school media center.
- Destruction of school records.
- Vandalism which closes the school

MONETARY COST

Type III Vandalism

Incidents having a low monetary cost but a high social cost.

Examples

1. Racial graffiti.

- Systematic vandalizing of minority-owned property.
- Killing of classroom animals

Low

Type II Vandalism

Incidents having a high monetary cost but a low social cost.

Examples

- Large number of broken windows.
- Cherry bomb dropped in a toilet.
- Vandalism to vending machines.

Type IV Vandalism

Incidents having both a low monetary cost as well as a low social cost.

Examples

- 1. Tire tracks in the lawn.
- Cutting of the flag-pole rope.
- Painting of names on the bleachers.
- 4. Single broken windows.
