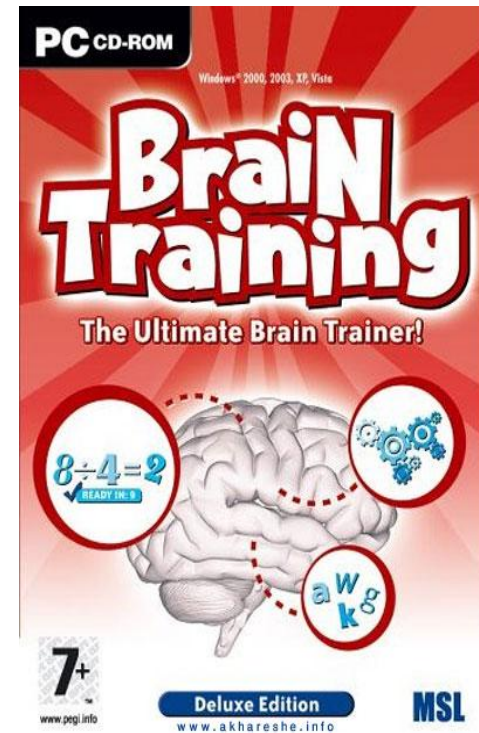

# DIFFERENCES BEGINNERS vs ADVANCED

- More difficult reasoning
- Longer
- Faster
- More formal
- More technical
- Denser



# ADDED DIFFICULTIES

- More abstraction
- Complex phraseology
- Less redundancy
- More complicated syntax (disjointed, sub-clauses)
- More refined vocabulary
- Wider range in register
- Greater speed
- READ TEXTS

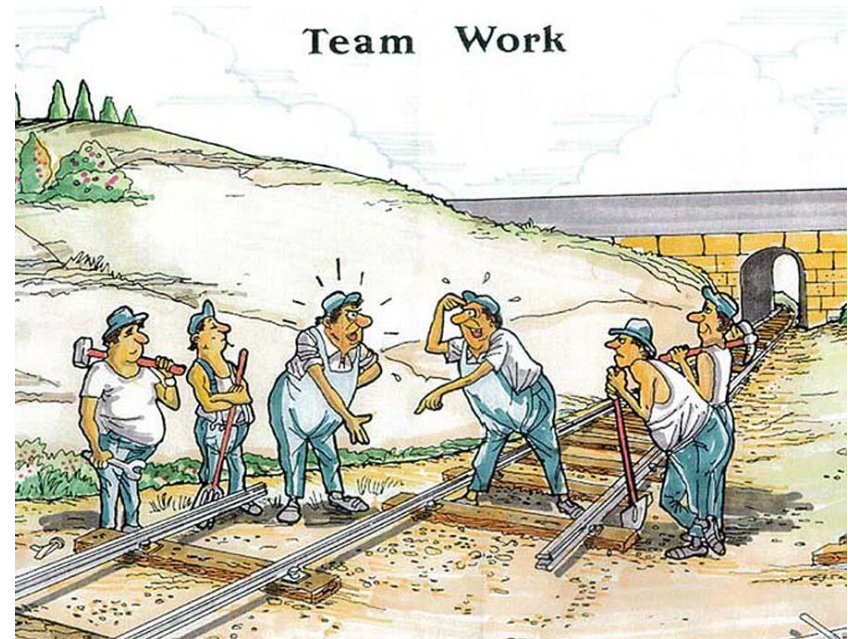
- Types
