



#### **GENOCIDES & HUMAN RIGHTS (USHMM)**

**Genocide** is an internationally recognized crime where acts are committed with the intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, ethnic, racial, or religious group. These acts fall into five categories:

- 1. Killing members of the group
- 2. Causing serious bodily or mental harm to members of the group
- **3**. Deliberately inflicting on the group conditions of life calculated to bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part
- 4. Imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group
- **5**. Forcibly transferring children of the group to another group

On December 9, 1948, the United Nations approved a written international agreement known as the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide.

## MEMORY STUDIES IN BRIEF

"Memory studies is a **multidisciplinary field** which combines intellectual strands from anthropology, education, literature, history, philosophy, psychology and sociology, among others. Historians who study collective memory use the work of French sociologist Maurice Halbwachs (1925, 1941) (inspired by Durkheim) as a primary theoretical reference point. (...) Halbwachs argued that memory is not simply an individual phenomenon, but is **relational** in terms of family and friends, and also **societal and collective** in terms of the social frameworks of social groups." (Bosch 2016)

"The rediscovery of memory is associated with the **transformation** of these disciplines, paradigm changes, and modernization processes; nevertheless, it also depends on **technological progress** and a sense of urgency to capture memories of surviving witnesses of crucial historical events and processes of the 20<sup>th</sup> century." (CAS)




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#### How the War in Ukraine is Shaped by Its Past


