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A. Synagogue music of ~3000+ years: Te ‘amim - Biblical Accentuation and Cantillation

bereishit; bara [+] ‘elohim, ‘eit [+] *hashshamayim, ve’eit [+]* ha’aretz.

tippekha munnakh ‘etnakhta mer.cha tippekha mer.cha silluq

Genesis 1,1: God[+]created, in-the-beginning: the[+]heavens and-the[+]earth.

There exist six alterations of lectionaries of the same system of cantillation marks: (in the Ashkenazic rite)

1. tora: 5 Books of Moses. on weekdays, *shabat* & all festivals. 2. tora on New Year\rosh-hashshana) and the Day of Atonement\yom-kipur.

3. haftara - The Prophets\nevi’im: Joshua, Judges, Samuel, Kings, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezechiel and “The Twelve”. Extracts from those books are read in public only after the reading from *tora*. 4. The Writings\ketuvim: 4.1. The 3 Scrolls\megilot which are read on the three Pilgrimage Festivals. Song of Songs on *shabat* of Passover\pesach, Ruth on Pentecost\shavu’ot and Ecclesiastes on the *shabat* of Tabernacles\sukot. 4.2. The Scroll of ester on *purim*.

4.3. The Scroll of Lamentations\eycha on 9th of month *av*, marking the destruction of 2 Temples in Jerusalem: the 1st in year -586 and the 2nd in +70.

B. Synagogue music, Europe, ~1500 years old: nusach: daily, *tora*, *shabat*, festivals, High-Holidays, fast-days

Vyvolaný\Kantor: *barechu et ‘adonaj hamevorach!*

Žehnejte Hospodinu, požehnanému na věky a věčně!

Obec a po ní vyvolaný\ *baruch ‘adonaj hamevorach le ‘olam va‘ed.*

\kantor a po ní vyvolaný: Požehnán bud’ Hospodin, požehnaný navěky a věčně.

C. Synagogue music, Europe, ~200+ years old:

‘uvnicho jomar Když je svitek Tóry uložen do svaté schrány, říká obec: Music: Louis Lewandowski (1821 - 1894)

‘uvnicho jomar, šuva ‘adonaj, rivevot ‘alfej jisra’ejl.

A když spočinula, řekl: Vrať se, Hospodine, k myriádám tisíců Jisraele!

kuma ‘adonaj limnuchatecha, ‘ata va ‘aron ‘uzecha.

Vztyč se, Hospodine, ve svém klidu, ty a schrána tvé moci!

kohanecha jilbešu cedek, vachasidecha jeranejnu.

At’ se tví kněží obléknou v spravedlnost a tví zbožní at’ plesají.

ba ‘avur david ‘avdecha, ‘al tašejev penej mešichecha.

Pro Davida, svého služebníka, nezadržuj tvář svého pomazaného!

ki lekach tov natati lachem, torati ‘al ta ‘azovu.

Dal jsem vám dobrý dar, neopouštějte mou Tóru!

‘ejc chajim hi lamachazikim bah, vetomecheha me’ušar.

Je stromem života těm, které posiluje, a blažený, komu je oporou!

deracheha darchej no ‘am, vechol netivoteha šalom.

Její cesty jsou cesty přijemné a všechny její stezky jsou mír.

hašivejnu ‘adonaj ‘ejlecha, venašuva, chadejš Jamejnu kekedem.

Přived’ nás, Hospodina, zpátky k sobě a my se vrátíme, obnovuj naše dny tak jako kdysi!
