



• "Europe" has never been just geography. • Historically shaped by: • Culture

- Religion
- Civilization

• First used by Greeks — vague western label. • *Roman Empire = political unity, not* "Europeanness."

- identity.
- Europe vs. "Others": • Islam
  - Byzantium • Colonized worlds
- *Enlightenment: Europe = reason,* civilization, superiority. • Justified imperialism as "civilizing mission."



Crisis, Memory & the Peace Project

- 19th—20th c.: Nationalism fragmented Europe.
- World Wars = shared trauma.
- Post-war: Europe reimagined as peace project.
- EU built on remembrance, not just economics.

• Europe = idea shaped by who's included/excluded.

## The Case of Russia

- Transcontinental
- Geographically: 25% Europe, 75% Asia
- Population density & capital : west third of the country (i.e. European side)





The Case of Cyprus

- Geographically West Asian, culturally and geopolitically South-East European
  - EU member state
  - Turkish & Greek population
  - Significant role in Greek Mythology



The Case of Turkey

- (& potentially Armenia, Georgia and Azerbaijan)
- How they feel vs. how Europe feels
- Generally considered both European & West Asian
  - Cultural identity
  - Historical Ties
  - Political aspiration
- Ural mountains



What do Americans think of Europe?

- Stereotypes vs. Reality -Class Basis
- Exotification, flattening effect among youth
- Generally positive sentiments
- Most important region for security





#### How do Russians see Europe?

- Russia is no longer part of Europe
  - a "vast Eurasian and Euro-pacific power"
- 2021 study 64% of Russians didn't see themselves as a European country, only 29% did
  Western threat to Russian traditional values



# What do Chinese people think about Europe?

- Soft power triumphs, mainly among youth
- Divide between
   Western/Eastern
- Rich culture and history, unpolluted
   environments
