Credit conditions and credit system rules

Winter semester 2020/2021

To be awarded the credit, the student must complete:

1. The presence in at least **10 seminars within the winter semester is required** (according to Dean's Provision No. 1/2011). The number of required presences is determined regarding to the number of seminars canceled due to public holidays and vacations.
2. Collecting of at least **19 credit points** within the winter semester.

Credits can be gained by:

- **presence** in seminar - 1 credit / week
- **presentation** of one or more selected topics during seminars - up to 5 credits for 1 presented topic, each student must present at least one topic during the semester, students should not present more than one topic during one seminar. The list of topics will be displayed in the Moodle system.

- **activity** during discussion in each seminar

- **successful answering of test questions**

4 control tests will be performed during the winter semester. The areas of test questions will be:

1. General physiology, membrane potential
2. Heart and circulation
3. Blood
4. Breathing

It will be possible to gain 1 credit for each test.

Each student resolves the potential lack of credits in the end of semester with his own instructor individually.

Conditions for admission to the final exam in physiology:

- Successful completion of the course in *both* semesters.
