- Is this your book? – No, it is not my book. Maybe, it could be Petra's.

The Verb Have Got (sloveso mít/vlastnit)

- **Have you got** some time now? – Yes, **I have**.
 - Where **have you got** the form?

 - I might have one. Yes, **I have**.
- **Has she got** any time now? – Yes, **she has got** time.

The Verb Have Got – Negation (sloveso mít/vlastnit - Zápor)

The Verb Have Got - Question and Short Answer (sloveso mít/vlastnit – otázka a zkrácená odpověď)

- **Have you got** some time now? – Yes, **I have**.
- Where **have you got** the form?
- **Have you got** a pen? – I'm sorry, **I haven't got** a pen.
 - I might have one. Yes, **I have**.
- **Has she got** any time now? – Yes, **she has got** time.
 - **We've got** some time now.

You have got some time.

Fixed phrases with HAVE

- We can **have a coffee**.
- This is a special use of the verb have. Here it does not mean to own but the meaning is in the whole phrase.
 - **Have a coffee = dát si kávu**

Possessive Pronouns and Possessive Case (přivlastňovací zájmena a přivlastňovací pád)

- Is this **your** book? – No, it is not **my** book.
