## Examples from the Video

- ▶ On Saturday, I am going to meet my friend.
- ▶ Are you going to meet her in a café as usual? – No, I am not.
  - ▶ ... on Sunday, I'm going to relax at home.
- ▶ That's great that you're not going to work at the weekend.
  - ▶ I'm going to see my sister, her husband ....
    - ▶ We're going to meet in the afternoon.
      - ▶ Have you got any plans?
      - ▶ Sounds like a lovely plan.
- ▶ This time we would like to go for a walk.

## Future going to (positive affirmative – kladná oznamovací věta)

- On Saturday, I am going to meet my friend.
- ... on Sunday, I'm going to relax at home.
- I'm going to see my sister, her husband ....
  - We're going to meet in the afternoon.

Plural	
we	
you	
they	

# Future going to (negation – zápor)

- ▶ That's great that you're not going to work at the weekend.

Singular		
I	<b>am</b>	<i>going to <u>meet</u></i>
you	<b>are</b>	<i>going to <u>meet</u></i>
he, she, it	<b>is</b>	<i>going to <u>meet</u></i>

Plural		
we	<b>are</b>	<i>going to <u>relax</u></i>
you	<b>are</b>	<i>going to <u>relax</u></i>
they	<b>are</b>	<i>going to <u>relax</u></i>



**Future going to**  
**Question** and **Short Answer** (otázka a krátká odpověď)  
(sloveso mít/vlastnit – otázka a zkrácená odpověď)

- Are you going to meet her in a café as usual?
  - No, I am not.

You are going to meet her in a café.



## Usage of going to (použití going to)

- Have you got any plans?
- Sounds like a lovely plan.

# would like to

➔ This time **we would like to go** for a walk.

➔ **WOULD** = modal verb (modální sloveso) (jako CAN)
