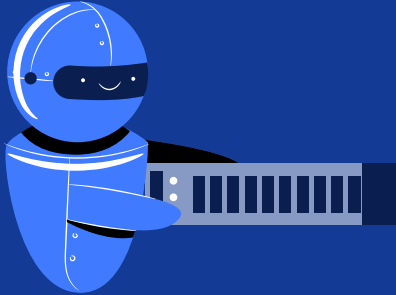

WHAT IS AUTOMATED JOURNALISM?





“ Automated journalism refers to the process of using **software or algorithms** to automatically generate news stories **without human intervention**—after the initial programming of the algorithm. ”

— (Graefe, 2017)

HOW IT WORKS

Collect data

- Pre-defined sources and/or data mining
- New and historical data, context data

Identify interesting events

- Statistical analysis (outliers, trends, correlations)
- Pre-defined rules per topic (e.g., runs per team determine winner)

Prioritize insights

- Newsworthiness
- Pre-defined rules (e.g. result more important than injuries)

Generate narrative

- Specification of storyline and structure
- Official style guide of the publisher

Publish story

- Through the publisher's content management system
- Either automatically or after editorial review

- Varies in complexity
- Emerged from the domain of sports reporting

INGENUITY

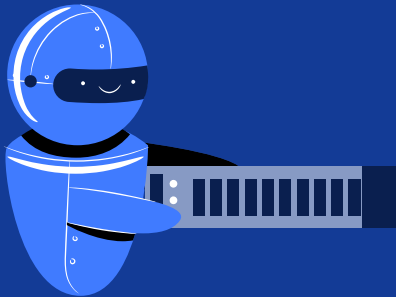
Lack ingenuity and cannot innovate
