Biggest short-term drop in economic activity in centuries



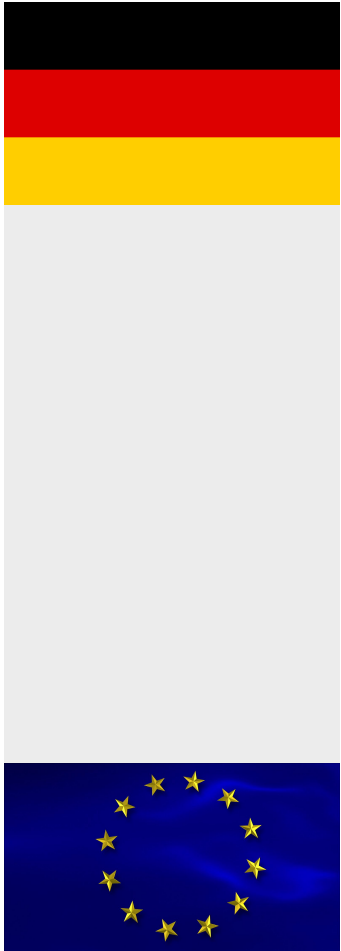
Long-term impact on aggregates like output, jobs, and prices – as well as the relationship between them

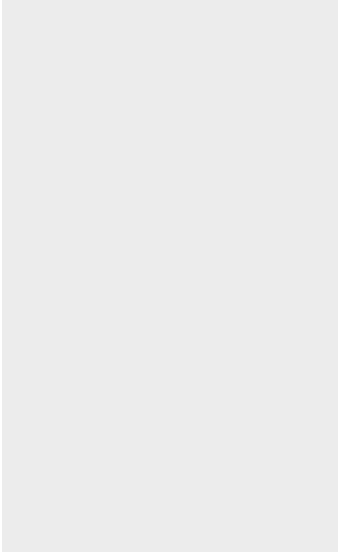

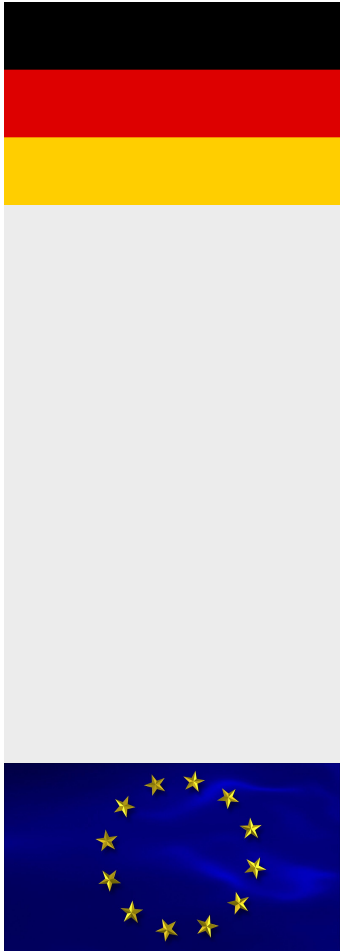

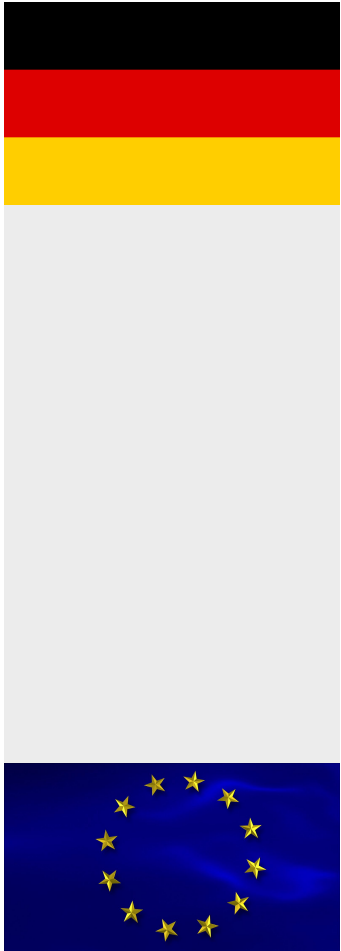
