Markéta: Yes, yes, yes. Here l've got it. Yeah, see, see here. She is quite a ...

Šárka: I can see the photos.

Markéta: ... but, oh, unfortunately, she died in 2018, yeah, this book is slightly older. OK.

Šárka: Oh no.

Markéta: So she's not here anymore, unfortunately.

Šárka: Yeah, that's sad news. But anyways, it's an amazing story and amazing ability, right.
