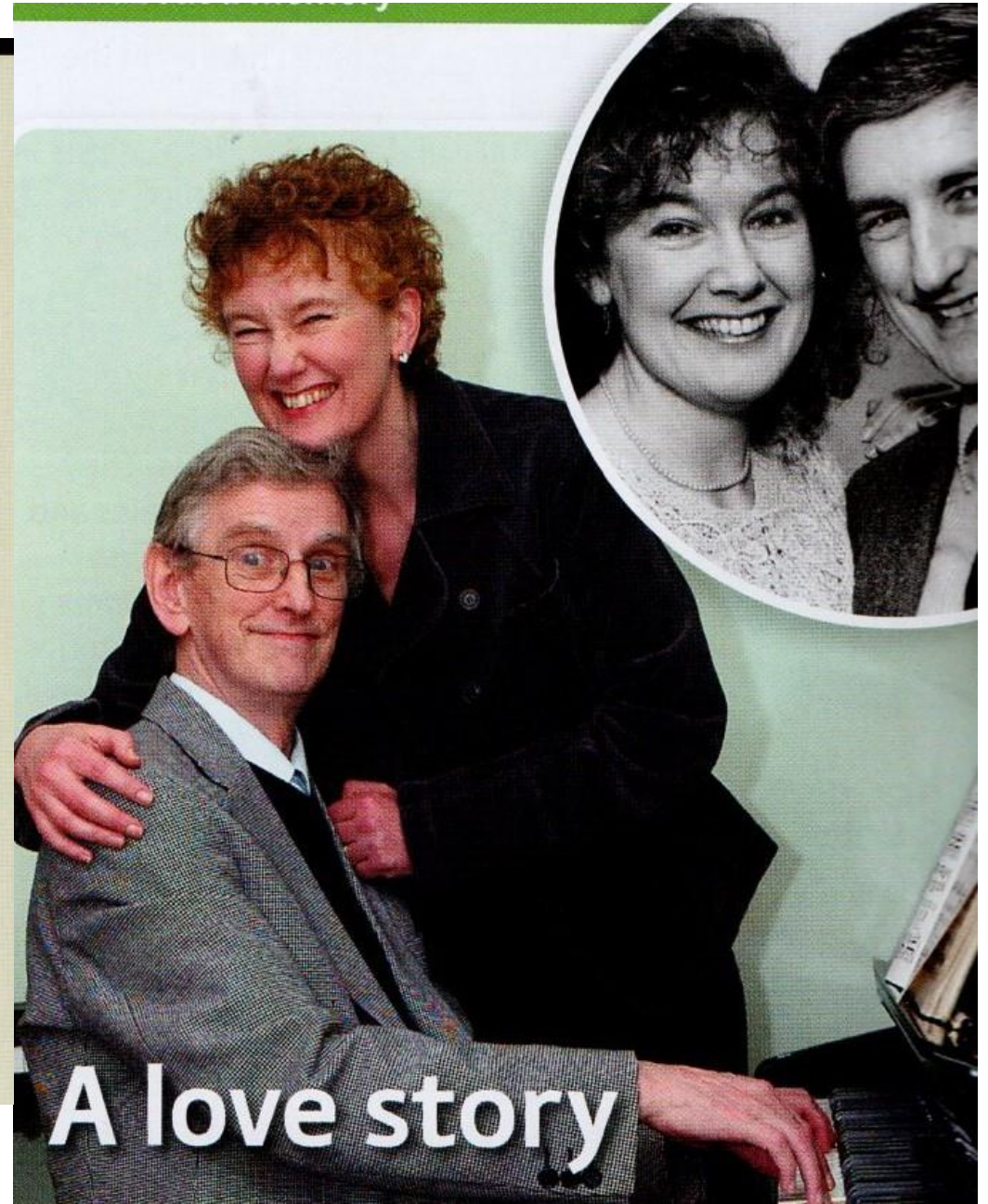

regular verbs: studied, remembered, moved

They **met** in London in 1978.

- met – minulý tvar od slovesa *meet*
