The Jim Thompson House museum

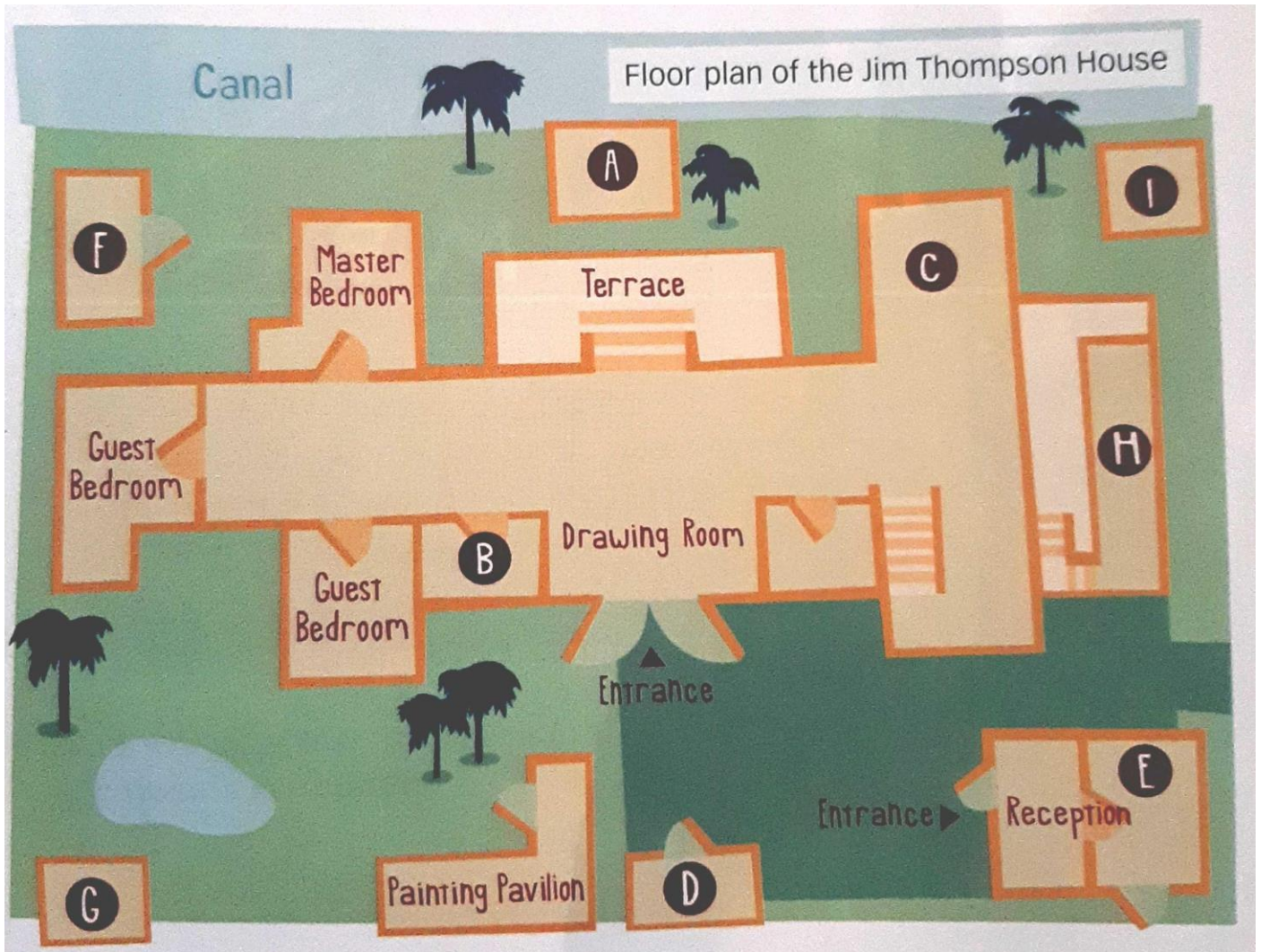
The hand-drawn map shows a section of Bangkok with the following landmarks and locations:
