Types and collection of data

- Observational data
 - Surveys
 - Labor Force Survey (LFS), Census, Household Budget Survey (HBS)
 - Administrative data
 - Different registries, tax records, unemployed
 - Collect data yourself
 - Ex.: stock exchange, basketball games
- Experimental data (labs, field)

Surveys Sampling techniques

- Simple random sampling
- Stratified cluster sampling (2 or more stages)
 - Strata division of population according to some characteristics (e.g. NUTS4 region)
 - Need for clustering (if stratas are specific)
 - We need to weight using the weight of strata in population to get representative estimates

Surveys Biased samples

- Response-based sampling
 - Ex: In a study of the determinants of number of visits to a recreational site, only those with at least one visit are included
- Length-biased sampling
 - Ex: Measure of the average duration of unemployment (look at currently unemployed x look at people currently leaving unemployment)
- Sample selection
 - Effect of training (problem = selection of people into training)

Surveys Quality of data

- No-response: as participation is voluntary
- Missing data
 - High income respondents not willing to respond to questions about income
- Measurement errors
 - # of sexual partners: women 4, men 7 (USA)
- Attrition (in panel data)

Surveys Types of data

- Cross-section X panel data x time series
 - Repeated cross section data
 - Balanced x unbalanced panels
- Qualitative / quantitative (race / wage)
